## Entry Guidelines

1. All entries must have a valid, public YouTube URL. Please double check that your URL is valid before submitting it.
2. Enter a project only once.
3. Each project may only be submitted to ONE category - either Curricular or Craft.
4. Teachers or program coordinators submit all entries. All communication from the festival will be sent to the teacher responsible for the entry.
5. Each teacher is limited to a maximum of THREE total entries.
6. Entries must be received by 11:59 p.m. PST on the day of the submission deadline.
7. Entries must represent work that was completed after April 15 of the previous year.
8. Store a complete, high-resolution copy of your project, as this is required for all winning projects.
9. Please be sure you have permission on file for all of the students featured in your project. It will be your responsibility to save all forms releasing student likeness until requested by media festival officials.
