



Family-friendly Attractions near Los Angeles Public Library

OUE Skyspace Plaza Area (Former Observation Deck Site)*

While the observation deck is closed, the surrounding plaza remains a lively, walkable area with great city views.

Pershing Square*

An open urban park where families can relax, view colorful art, people-watch, and enjoy occasional weekend events.

The Last Bookstore*

A whimsical, maze-like bookstore filled with art installations and used books that kids love exploring.

Grand Central Market*

A bustling food hall with kid-friendly treats—from ice cream to tacos—perfect for a casual weekend bite; lively without being overwhelming.

Angels Flight Railway

A low-cost, short, historic funicular ride that delights children and connects you to the lively Grand Central Market.

Museum of Contemporary Art*

A variety of contemporary art mainly for teens and adults; reservations recommended.

The Broad (Exterior + Plaza)*

Free general admission to the contemporary art museum (timed tickets recommended but not required for outdoor areas) Even without timed tickets, families can enjoy the outdoor plaza, large-scale sculptures, and the museum's striking architecture.

Walt Disney Concert Hall (Exterior Walk)*

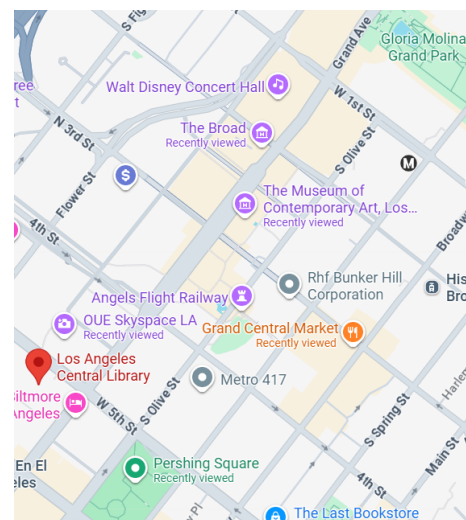
Kids enjoy wandering the curved metal walkways (with cool echoes) around this iconic Frank Gehry building.

Gloria Molina Grand Park* (.8 mile walk)

A 12-acre civic park with free public programming and green spaces to explore.

Grammy Museum* (for youth) (.8 mile walk southwest of LAPL)

Several ongoing and special exhibits, including an interactive sonic playground
